## WASHING PROCEDURE USING THE JAR

- 1. Place the pipette into the basket
- 2. Fill in the jar with the washing liquid (detergent/distilled water)
- 3. Leave the basket in position for sufficient time to clean the pipettes (two/three hours)
- 4. Remove the basket from the jar
- 5. Place the basket into the automatic pipette washer
- 6. Connect the pipe attachment provided to the automatic pipette washer (siphon connection)
- 7. Connect the water tap to the pipe attachment by means of a rubber or PVC tube (internal Ø 13mm not supplied)
- 8. Connect the outlet tube from the base to the drain



## WASHING AND RINSING PROCEDURE DIRECLY INTO THE AUTOMATIC PIPETTE WASHER

- 1. Fill the pipette washer with water
- 2. Add the detergent
- 3. Turn the water tap on and allow the system running until the rinsing is complete

## WASHING PROCEDURE BY DISTILLED WATER DIRECTLY INTO THE AUTOMATIC PIPETTE WASHER

- 1. Fill the pipette washer with distilled water
- 2. Place the basket containing the pipettes already washed with ordinary water inside the automatic pipette washer and proceed with the rinsing by distilled water

## WARNING

In case of use of chromic mixture NEVER prepare it directly in the container. Polyethylene resists up to a temperature of 80/90 ° C. It is therefore advisable to pour the cold ready made mixture, in and place the container in a 15-20 liter Polyethylene basin to avoid accidental spills of the chromic mixture.
